Thank you for your interest in our 95-gallon recycling cart program. According to the United States Environmental Protection Agency, there are several benefits to recycling household waste. Recycling reduces the need for landfilling, and incineration, saves energy, conserves natural resources and helps sustain the environment for future generations. Vogel Disposal Service, Inc. is proud to provide you with an enhanced one-cart comingled recycling program to help simplify your recycling efforts.

In addition to a list of items that can be recycled, we have included for you some guidelines for you to follow when placing your recycling cart out for collection:

- ✓ ALL RECYCLING MATERIAL MUST BE INSIDE THE CART. Any material outside the cart will be considered trash and will not be collected. Please remember to break down your cardboard items to save space in your cart.
- ✓ DO NOT OVERLOAD YOUR CART. Don't put more in your cart than it can hold with its lid closed.
- ✓ During winter months, clear snow from around the carts and keep lids closed to prevent rain and snow from collecting inside and causing items to freeze to the bottom. DRIVERS WILL NOT REACH INTO YOUR CART TO REMOVE LOOSE ITEMS THAT ARE FROZEN TO THE BOTTOM OF CART.

Also, for tracking purposes, each cart has a serial number which we will record and match to a specific address. If you sell your home or move, please contact our office to arrange for removal of the cart prior to stopping your service.

As previously mentioned, this recycling program includes many additional items that can be recycled, such as cardboard, junk mail, and a large variety of plastics. Listed on the next page are the items accepted for recycling and the items not accepted for recycling. **Please retain for future reference.**

95 GALLON RECYCLING CART GUIDELINES

MATERIAL	WHAT CAN BE RECYCLED	WHAT <u>CANNOT</u> BE RECYCLED	PREPARE MATERIALS FOR RECYCLING
GLASS	Clear, amber and green glass from beverage bottles and food jars	Window glass, light bulbs, crystal, glass tumblers, ceramics, mirrors, ovenware	Rinse bottles and jars, remove and discard lids, DO NOT BREAK GLASS (labels may be left on)
METAL	Aluminum, steel, bi-metal food and beverage cans, aerosol cans, clean aluminum foil and foil products	Clothes hangers, aluminum siding, screws and nails, toys, lawn furniture, greasy foil, cans containing food, paint cans	Rinse cans (crush if space is needed) Please push lid down inside can Wipe out greasy containers
PLASTIC (PET, HDPE)	Plastic containers #1 through #6 on bottoms, plastic bags (bundled), plastic milk containers, baby wipe containers, bleach, detergent, household cleaner bottles, yogurt, cottage cheese and margarine containers, shampoo bottles	Plastic containers #7, styrofoam peanuts and blocks, loose plastic bags, plastic plant pots, foam plastic egg cartons, plastic wrap, bubble wrap	Rinse, remove and discard lids (crush if space is needed) (LIDS ARE NOT RECYCLABLE. BE SURE TO REMOVE AND DISCARD IN YOUR TRASH)
PAPER	Corrugated and pressed cardboard cartons, paperboard boxes (cereal, tissue, shoes, etc.), white office paper, computer paper, magazines, newspapers, advertising inserts, junk mail (including envelopes), catalogs, phone books, paperbound books, colored construction paper, coupons, receipts, paper shopping bags	Pizza boxes, hardback books, wax paper, milk cartons, juice boxes, take-out food containers, Christmas wrapping paper	-Flatten boxes and cartons -Remove shopping bag handles -Staples may be left in -Place shredded paper in a brown paper bag -DO NOT PUT NEWSPAPERS AND MAGAZINES IN PLASTIC BAGS
